

Young Adults Gathering Internship

Position Description (Updated February 2024)

Purpose of Position

The Young Adults Gathering Coordinator internship is responsible for being an energizer, leader, and consistent presence at our Thursday gatherings and After Party's. They will have tangible opportunities to grow in their leadership, communication and planning skills to make our gatherings fun, excellent, and communal, so that Young Adults can experience a more vibrant relationship with Christ and better engage in the life of our community.

Skills and Qualifications

- Affirms Engedi's Leadership Covenant
- Has a positive, teachable and hospitable attitude.
- Tithes to Engedi church (willing to start if not already)
- Is willing to complete the Journey Class and become a part of a CABLE group
- Is willing to attend and serve at *most* YA Gatherings on Thursday nights from 6:00 pm -9:00 pm.
- Ability to recruit, develop, and communicate with volunteers

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Works closely with the Engedi Young Adults Pastor and Young Adults Coordinator via regular touch-ins.
- Assist in planning and execution of our Thursday Gatherings and After-Party's
- Develop communication ability for hosting or teaching from the platform as opportunity and competency allows
- Communicate and coordinate with team members/leaders to ensure all details for Thursday gatherings are confirmed
- Communicate regularly to the Young Adults who have connected via various forms of communication to help them take next steps into the life of Engedi

- Assist in identifying, recruiting, developing and empowering Young Adults team leaders/members.
- Assist in managing the department's communications and marketing for our Gatherings.

Other Expectations

- Participate in weekly staff prayer times (every Monday at 1:15pm)
- Participate in Monday staff meetings (monthly)
- Participate in Young Adult staff meetings (weekly) 2-3pm.
- Participate in monthly department meetings
- Participate in weekly spiritual formation class on Wednesday mornings
- Participate in weekly leadership class on Monday evenings
- Complete study materials including books, blogs, podcasts, etc as assigned
- Attend weekly worship gatherings, belong to a CABLE group, serve as a volunteer, give financially to the ministry of Engedi
