

Young Adults Groups Internship

Position Description (Updated February 2024)

Purpose of Position

The Young Adults Groups Internship will provide coordination and discipleship for Young Adults to get connected into Engedi's small groups. They will have tangible opportunities to grow in their leadership, communication, and discipleship skills. Small groups allow Young Adults to experience a more vibrant relationship with Christ and better engage in the life of our community.

Skills and Qualifications

- Affirms <u>Engedi's Leadership Covenant</u>
- Has a positive, teachable and hospitable attitude.
- Tithes to Engedi church (willing to start if not already)
- Is willing to complete the Journey class and become a part of a CABLE group
- Is willing to attend and serve at least once a month at YA on Thursday nights from 7:00 -8:30pm.
- Ability to recruit, develop, and communicate with volunteers

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Works closely with the Engedi Young Adults pastor and Young Adults coordinator via regular touch-ins.
- Work closely with Julie Vroon (Engedi Groups Coordinator) to stay up to date on system database, trainings for leaders and enhanced strategies to recruit and release new groups
- Communicate and coordinate with group members/leaders to ensure all details for discipleship and group assimilation takes place
- Assist in identifying, recruiting, developing and empowering Young Adults cable group leaders.

- Weekly contact work with young adults to help get integrated into CABLE groups
- Be a stage presence as opportunities allow for hosting
- Lead or Co-lead a CABLE group

Other Expectations

- Participate in weekly staff prayer times (every Monday at 1:15pm)
- Participate in Monday staff meetings (monthly)
- Participate in monthly department meetings
- Participate in weekly spiritual formation class on Wednesday mornings
- Participate in weekly leadership class on Monday evenings
- Complete study materials including books, blogs, podcasts, etc as assigned
- Attend weekly worship gatherings, belong to a CABLE group, serve as a volunteer, give financially to the ministry of Engedi
